## **USSA JUDO 2014 Nelson Mandela Metropolitan University Campus Rules**

---

1. Anyone who enters the property of the university shall be subject to the rules and regulations of the institution in as far as it concerns the general code of conduct and discipline.
2. Campus security may ask anyone on campus to provide some kind of identity. Participants in USSA Judo will have to produce a student card upon request.
3. Motor vehicles may be brought or kept on campus but driving and parking shall be at the owner's risk.
4. **NO GLASS ON CAMPUS.** This is a glass free campus, no glass bottles allowed on campus.
5. No firearms may be brought onto campus or housed in any part of the university property.
6. Anyone who causes damage to the university property shall be held liable for such damage.
7. The university does not accept liability for any damages or loss or theft of property arising out of any activity on the campus.
8. Meals will only be served on production of meal tickets.
9. No replacement meal tickets will be issued if tickets are lost, etc.
10. No smoking shall be allowed in the dining rooms.
11. No crockery and cutlery shall be removed from dining halls.
12. Anyone guilty of such offence shall be summarily dismissed.
13. Anyone who wishes to lodge complaints of any nature shall lodge such complaints via the team manager to the tournament directors.
14. No nudity allowed on campus.

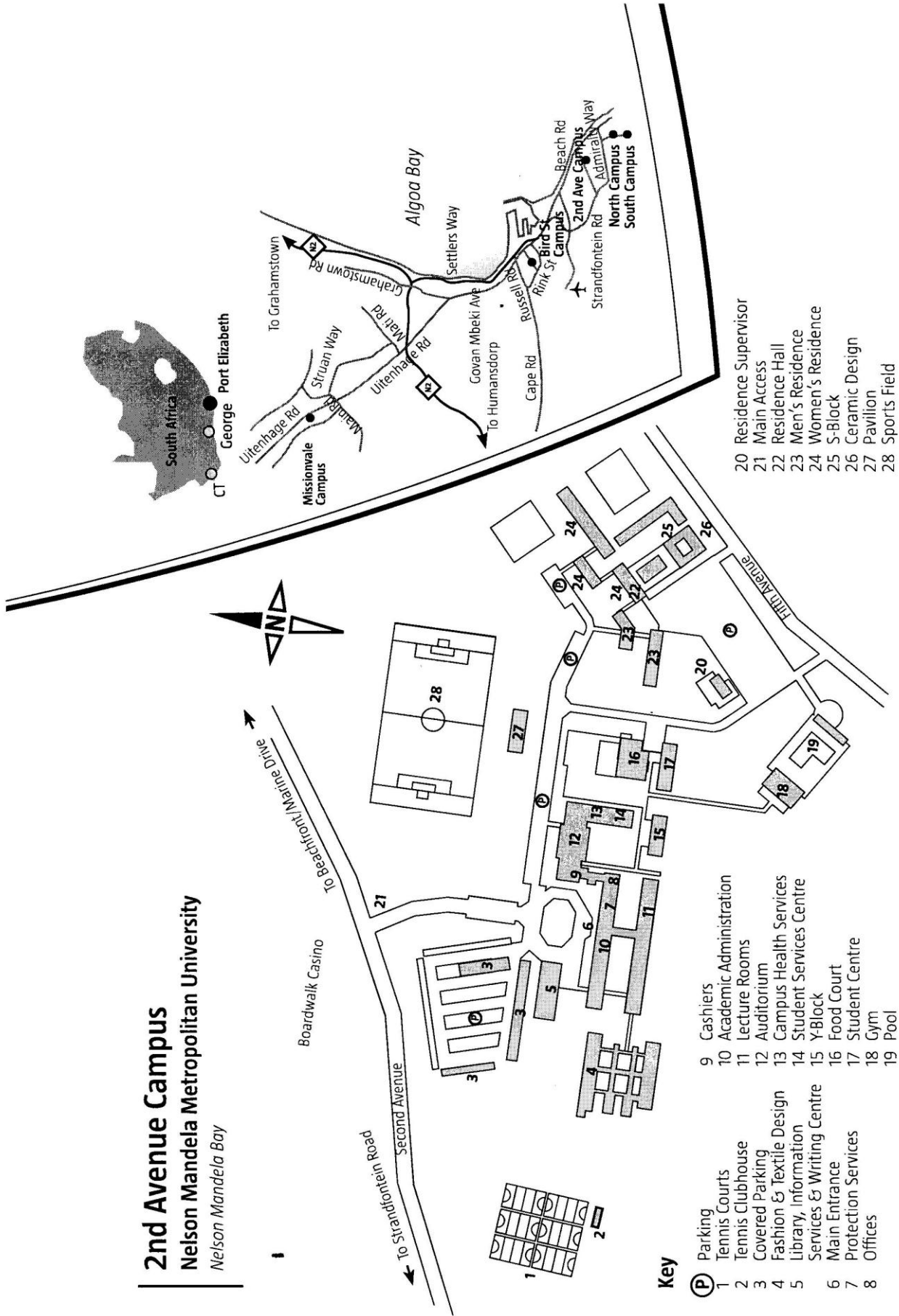
